#### 6 Tips on Selecting the right PWC for you

Your Power Wheelchair (PWC) is probably the most expensive item of Assistive Technology you own, apart from your vehicle. For the average PWC user, the typical equipment lifespan is around 4-5 years, so it is critical that you make the right decision when selecting your equipment.

As a leading provider of PWC and other specialised equipment for clients with special needs since 1952, Astris PME is well placed to share some advice based on their experience. This simple guide has been put together by leading Equipment Consultants, with input from many PWC users across a wide range of conditions (clinical and physical needs), ages and geographic locations.

Before deciding on what model Powered Wheelchair to apply for funding for, we have put together a short checklist of 6 things we recommend.

- 1. Get good advice. Never rush a decision that will have an impact on you over a longer time frame. Ask your therapist what equipment they recommend, based on their knowledge of your situation and goals, and other factors. Connect with an experienced Assistive Technology Professional (ATP), and get their recommendations and advice. Remember cheaper is not always better, and you don't want to be stuck with a decision that is letting you down. Balance "value for money", with the right purchase decision for you. Trial before you buy!
- 2. Consider your clinical needs. Work with your therapist to ensure that the equipment will suit your needs, both now and in the future. If your needs are changing, you may consider hire option. Although this costs more than an outright purchase, it may suit you better if your needs are changing.
- **3.** Consider your goals. Consider your education, employment and inclusion goals, and ensure that this investment will put you on track to achieve these goals.
- 4. Consider your seating system. A great chair with a poor seating system equals a bad investment. Make sure your therapist and ATP are making decisions as to your comfort and support, not just on the powered base.
- 5. Consider post sale support. A PWC has many moving parts, and things will go wrong. Ask about the warranty, about programmed maintenance packages, and about how your supplier looks after after-sale support (incl breakdowns). This is extremely important if you work away from home, or live in a remote area.
- 6. Consider a MWC with Power Add-On. Lastly, before you jump in and purchase a PWC, consider if a manual chair with a removable power assist or power-add on would better suit your needs. Discuss this option with your therapist and ATP.



#### Power mobility was revolutionised with the introduction of Mid-Wheel Drive (MWD) because it offered a small turning radius for improved manoeuvring in tight spaces. The need for Front-Wheel (FWD) and Rear-Wheel Drive (RWD) powerchairs was not diminished by this introduction because they offer completely different options and benefits.



**FWD**: Drive wheels are at the front of the wheelchair and two caster wheels at the rear.. The front drive wheel provides a smoother passage when the chair transitions over obstacles.



**MWD**: Drive wheels are directly under the wheelchair with four caster wheels on the ground – two in front of the drive wheel and two behind the drive wheel. A tight turning radius means a MWD chair is Ideal for indoor use.



**RWD**: Drive wheels are at the rear of the wheelchair and the two casters are at the front. Good outdoor performance. Provides anterior stability for straight tracking.

Note: Consideration should be given to the needs of the user, the environment the wheelchair will be used and clinician advice. Arranging a trial before deciding is advised.
